They also carry a full line of wood finishing products.


Parkerville will also cut, plane, and shape wood that you may purchase from them.

The April Demo, "Spindle Turning", was given by the Master of Spindle Turning, Jim Kephart.

Some of the techniques Jim discussed and illustrated:

- *Centering the wood piece on the lathe
- *Woodturning safety

Tool rest clearance

Lathe speed

*The A, B, C's of woodturning—A-anchor the tool on the tool rest

B-ride the <u>bevel</u> of the tool on the wood

C-<u>cut</u> the wood by slowly raising the tool handle

- *Using the roughing gouge
- *Using the skew
- *Using the parting tool
- * Cutting tapers
- * Cutting beads
- * Cutting coves
